

## **Environmental Sustainability Coordinator**

The City of Fredericksburg (named by <u>Southern Living</u> as one of the best small towns in the South) is seeking an Environmental Sustainability Coordinator in the Public Works Department. Under limited supervision, this position is responsible for providing management, oversight, and City-wide departmental support of environmental sustainability programs and initiatives. The position manages and coordinates a variety of environmental programs and initiatives including but not limited to: solid waste and recycling programs, energy research and savings and management programs, green infrastructure planning. Acts as the department's environmental liaison to the Clean and Green Commission, R-Board, and other environmental groups and organizations. The position is responsible for ensuring that the City's plans, policies, facilities and property comply with all applicable pollution prevention requirements. This job is considered essential personnel and will be required to work during and following natural disasters and emergency situations.

Bachelor's degree in Environmental Science or Engineering, Environmental Policy, Energy Management, Environmental Resources Management or related field, with a minimum two (2) years of experience in the environmental field; or any equivalent combination of training and experience which provides the required skills, knowledge and experience and abilities. Prior experience with grant writing and administration is preferred, though not required. Master's degree, Certified Energy Manager (CEM), and Leadership in Energy & Environmental Design (LEED) Certification(s) a plus.
