- Inspect sick animals and administer prescription medications under the direction of a veterinarian;
- Interact with the public to provide information on the shelter animals or to assist with adoptions, reclaims, and transfers to rescues;
- Transport animals to veterinarian, groomer, or other locations as directed;
- Clean/sanitize/disinfect cages, kennels, and litter areas, administrative areas, surgical areas, and restrooms;
- Perform routine record keeping;
- May perform other duties as assigned by supervisor.

High school diploma/equivalent GED or vocational training required. Candidate must have a valid, insurable driver's license. As a position having safety-sensitive duties, background/DMV screening and **drug & alcohol testing** are required. Starting pay **\$32,910/year** depending on experience/qualifications, plus excellent benefits (health, dental, and vision, flex spending, life, disability, state & optional retirement, wellness programs, onsite clinic, and much more).
