





#### Registration

#### **Voting Credentials**

Article VI of the VACo bylaws provides that each county is to designate a representative of its Board of Supervisors to vote at the annual business meeting. However, the bylaws allow a county to designate a proxy to vote if a member of the Board of Supervisors cannot be present for this meeting. Counties should have received the 2024 VACo Voting Credential forms by email during September. The completed forms should be returned to **finance@vaco.org**. Forms are located at www.vaco.org/advocacy/steeringcommittees under Operations Committees/ Credentials. You can also drop the completed form off at the conference registration desk before the Credentials Committee meeting takes place on Monday, November 11 at 1 p.m. in the Monroe room.

#### Military Appreciation and Leadership Lessons

It's Veterans Day, and we will recognize and honor our Veterans. We are privileged to have decorated veterans who serve as County Supervisors, and several VACo leaders will share their experiences and how military leadership applies to their county work.

The Honorable Victor S. Angry | Supervisor, Prince William County

After graduating from Lyman High School in June 1986, Supervisor Angry enlisted into the United States Army where he served



honorably for over 23 years rising through the ranks from Private to Command Sergeant Major. In 2009, Supervisor Angry served in the position as the Interim Command Sergeant Major of the entire Army National Guard, representing over 368,200 soldiers and their family members. He was the first African American to be assigned to this position. He achieved numerous military awards and received two Legions of Merit. It was in the Army where Supervisor Angry developed a love for leadership, fitness and the commitment to lead and serve others.

The Honorable Mike R. Turner Supervisor, Loudoun County

Supervisor Turner is a 1973 graduate of the U.S. Air Force Academy and a former command pilot with more than 3,500 flying hours as both an air rescue



helicopter pilot and a fighter pilot. A Desert Storm veteran, he served on the U.S. Central

Command staff before and during the war. Turner's final assignment was on the Joint Staff in the Pentagon in support of the Chairman of the Joint Chiefs of Staff from 1993-1997, where he worked in the Strategic Plans and Policy Directorate. Turner is a recipient of the Bronze Star Medal, the Defense Superior Service Medal and the Air Medal.

Supervisor in November 2011.
He was elected Chairman
of the Board for 2021. He

Historic state and federal investments in broadband infrastructure have put Virginia on the path to connecting all communities to fast and reliable internet. \$1.4 billion in federal funds through the Broadband Equity, Access, and Deployment (BEAD) program have been allocated to Virginia to close this digital divide. In addition to building the infrastructure to connect approximately 100,000 remaining locations with no, or inadequate, internet service, BEAD funds will go towards developing innovative

programs to invest in non-deployment uses such as broadband adoption and affordability. This session will provide an overview of these programs and how counties can ensure their communities are fully participating in connecting to the internet.







## About the development and adoption of VACo's annual legislative program

- 1. In January the VACo President appoints VACo members to the eight VACo steering committees and names chairs and vice chairs. The eight steering committees are Agriculture and Rural Affairs; Community, Economic, and Workforce Development; Education; Environment, Energy, and Land Use; Finance and Elections; General Government; Health and Human Resources; and Transportation.
- **2.** VACo members are invited to attend regional meetings held April-September throughout the VACo regions in the Commonwealth to identify and discuss key legislative issues.
- 3. The steering committees meet once in late summer and again in November during the annual conference. The Steering Committees develop their position statements for the annual Legislative Program, based in part on information received during the regional meetings.
- **4.** In early Fall, prior to the annual conference, the membership receives a Preliminary Legislative Program. This draft is revised during the annual conference.
- **5.** The VACo Resolutions Committee oversees the development of the annual Legislative Program. It meets during the annual conference in November. The Resolutions Committee includes the six members of VACo's Executive Committee and the chairs and vice chairs of VACo's eight steering committees. VACo's President-Elect chairs the Resolutions Committee.
- **6.** The VACo membership adopts the new Legislative Program during the annual business meeting on the last day of the annual conference in November.


