

The County of Patrick is accepting applications from qualified applicants for the position of Information Technology Director. Duties include, but are not limited to, management, technical, and administrative work to plan, coordinate, implement, secure, and supervise the County's computers, information technology operations, and data resources. The successful candidate will oversee the purchase of computer hardware, software, and attached systems, manage system integration and specialized programs, and maintain and improve the efficiency and effectiveness of the county's information technology services. The ideal candidate will have demonstrated expertise in network infrastructure, IT project management, and cybersecurity, along with excellent communication and troubleshooting skills. Knowledge of Windows and Windows Server is required.

A Bachelor's degree in Computer Science, Information Technology, or Information Systems is preferred. Candidates with a combination of education and experience equivalent to a bachelor's degree in these areas will be considered. Certifications in various Microsoft software, Wide Area Networks, Local Area Networks, security, and web development are also preferred.

This is a full-time position with benefits exceeding \$25,000 annually, which include vacation and sick leave, life and health insurance, and retirement. Annual salary range is \$50,000 – \$70,000. Hours will be 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Monday through Friday. Evening, weekend, holiday, and flexible/irregular work schedules may be required.
