The Advocate will serve as a liaison between the prosecutors, victims, and witnesses as developments occur in cases. This position also assists victims with compensation forms and referrals to community services and promotes awareness of victims' rights in the community. This position serves the Montgomery County Commonwealth's Attorney.

Bachelor's Degree in Criminal Justice, Social Work, Counseling, or related field; or a combination of education and experience in counseling or human services environment. Knowledge of the criminal justice system, both state and local. The successful candidate will have demonstrated the ability to work effectively with people and to communicate effectively, both orally and in writing, and the ability to work calmly with people in emotional and unpredictable situations. Prior experience in grant writing or grant compliance is preferred.
