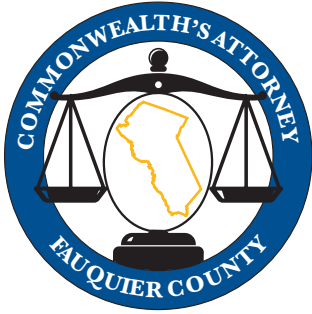




Summer of Justice: A Career in Public Service Begins Here
