How Does Hybrid Search Work?







INTRODUCTION

Chesterfield County defines "artificial intelligence" or "AI" to be a machine-based system that can, for a given set of human-defined objectives, make predictions, recommendations, or decisions influencing real or virtual environments. AI systems use machine- and human-based inputs to perceive real and virtual environments; abstract such perceptions into models through analysis in an automated manner; and use model inference to formulate options for information or action.

This policy establishes a comprehensive, yet flexible, governance structure for AI systems used by, or on behalf of Chesterfield County for the benefit of the community while safeguarding against potential harms by establishing our commitment to the responsible and ethical utilization of AI technologies, along with guidelines for innovating within each community of practice. It is the responsibility of county departments and functional areas that may decide to begin using AI technologies to ensure that the sources of data that are being interrogated are up-to-date and reliably accurate, as well as confirming that output from the AI-prompted inquiries are truthful and trustworthy.


